The Leinster Solo Championships is a 'stand-alone' competition, however the results will form part of an Irish Pipe Band Association Solo League. The league will be determined by the aggregated scores of competitors placed in all three events.

The results of the league will be announced on 24th March at the Leinster Championships.

Competitors will play in their own grade and the Open Grade if so desired.
No 'playing – up' a grade.

Tenor & Bass Drummers will play in grades corresponding to their band grade.
Competitions will be held for the following grades: Grade 1/2, 3, 4A & 4B (5).

New Solo Piping & Snare Drumming Grading

- Grade 1 - Senior
- Grade 2 - Intermediate
- Grade 3 - Junior A
- Grade 4 - Junior B
- Grade 5 - Novice

Note

- Stewards will be present to advise competitors of the competing time, however, it is the responsibility of the player to ensure that they are available to compete when called. Failure to present on time may lead to exclusion from the competition.
- Snare, Bass & Tenor Drummers must have the appropriate accompaniment available when called to compete.

A canteen facility will be available on the day with beverages, light snacks and meals.

- Late entries will attract a penalty of €5 added to the entry fee.

General Rules Governing Solo Contests

General

- Under Age Competitors: Confined to competitors who have not attained the age, on the 1st of November, 2017.
- Grade 5 (Novice) is open to pipers and drummers who have not won at U 16 Solo level.
- A player competing in a competitive grade can only play in the assigned grade and the Open Grade – no playing up a grade.
- Pipers are allowed a 3 minute tuning slot prior to their performance.
- Uniform must be worn by all competitors at the presentation of prizes.
- It should be made clear in future that it is the responsibility of the player/competitor to ensure that there are in time to play.
- Only registered or 'bona fide' Bass Drummers should be allowed to compete in the Bass Drumming contest.

League Scoring

- The first six placed competitors will receive points in inverse to placing order i.e. 1st place = 6 points, 6th place = 1 point.
- If less than six players participate in a grade, the first placed competitors will receive points in inverse to placing order i.e. four competitors - 1st place = 4 points etc.
- At the end of the three rounds, scores will be accumulated and the player with the highest score in each grade will be deemed to have won the Solo League in that grade.
- If there is a tie, the winner will be determined by the player who has competed in the most events.
