Competition Grades

Practice Chanter/Drum Pads

Novice and Advanced sections are confined to competitors who have never competed with a band in a competition

Novice:

Confined to competitors who are aged under 12 as of 1st November 2021. Competitors who are aged 12 or over, on or before 1st November will not be eligible to enter.

Evidence of age must be produced on request

Advanced: Confined to competitors who are aged under 13 as of 1st November 2021. Competitors who are aged 13 or over, on or before 1st November will not be eligible to enter. Evidence of age must be produced on request

Novice Piping/Unaccompanied Snare*:

Confined to competitors who are aged under 13 as of 1st November 2021. Competitors who are aged 13 or over, on or before 1st November will not be eligible to enter. Evidence of age must be produced on request

U16 Piobaireachd:

Confined to competitors who are under 16 years of age on the 1st November, 2021, as specified by RSPBA and IPBA rules. Evidence of age must be produced on request.

^{*} A competitor in the Pipe Chanter/Unaccompanied Snare Grade can only remain in this grade for one competitive season.

Playing Requirements

Novice	Four parts of Quick March, in any time signature
Advanced	Four part 2/4 March or 6/8 March
Unaccompanied/Pipe Chanter	Four parts of Quick March, in any time signature
U16 Piobaireachd	Urlár (ground) & 1st Variation

Prizes

- Medals will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each grade.
- Only the top three competitors will be placed in each competitive grade.
- A Certificate of Merit will be presented to participants in all grades.

Rules

- Competitors must register on arrival at the competition venue.
- It is each competitor's responsibility to present themselves to the adjudicator in the room provided at the allocated performance slot.
- A competitor having cause to protest must lodge same with a deposit of £/€ 10.00 with the
 contest secretary before the presentation of prizes. The deposit will be returned if the
 protest is upheld.
- The maximum amount of time available for tuning bagpipes in the Piobaireachd competition room is 3 minutes.
- Practice Pad & Unaccompanied Drumming performances must start with two 3 paced introductory rolls.
- The wearing of uniform is encouraged, though not strictly necessary.
